## A-LEVEL SUCCESS

RDUTC has been named as one of the best schools in the country for the progress made by A-level students.

New league tables released by the Department for Education show we are ranked 15<sup>th</sup> of all schools and colleges in England, including fee-paying independent schools, for the progress made by our students who took their A-levels last summer.

Excluding independent schools, RDUTC is ranked as the 6<sup>th</sup> best for student progress, with a progress score of 0.72, which is officially rated as "well above average".
