



Financial Support Policy – KS4 Subsidised Travel Policy

For Academic Year 1 September 2026 to 31 August 2027

Our students traveling on East Yorkshire Motor Services (EYMS) are able to access cheap weekly or 30-day tickets using the East Yorkshire Motor Services (EYMS) Mobile Bus App. The phone then acts as a ticket. You can also buy a mobile ticket from the website and send it through to the app; ideal for parents who want to buy tickets for their children, or people who use a desktop computer during the day.

Students must first download the app for free from the [App Store](#) or [Google Play](#) and register with EYMS online using their Ron Dearing email account. When students buy their first tickets they need to then contact EYMS via the Give Feedback button so they can verify the account is a student of the UTC. If students don't do this, they won't be able to use their tickets. Contact should be made a few days before the ticket is used to allow EYMS time to verify the student.

Hull KAT Card

These are available at a cost of £2, plus £18.60 for your first weeks travel for anyone aged 19 and under. They can be used to travel from **Hull to Wawne, Cottingham, Willerby, Kirk Ella, Anlaby and Hessle on any Stagecoach or East Yorkshire bus.**

What is the Bursary?

The Key Stage 4 Travel Grant is a discretionary payment to help students eligible for the Free School Meals with travel costs to college. - **No other bursary award will be made to Key Stage 4 students.**

Am I Eligible?

Students eligible for the Free School Meals can apply to RDUTC for a contribution towards the costs of return transport from their home to RDUTC. We will only support the cheapest form of return travel to RDUTC.

The award for the school 2026/27 will be limited to £20 per week during term time. A higher amount may be awarded, at the discretion of the principal, in exceptional circumstances when significant travel costs can be proven. Should attendance in the academic year fall below 95%, RDUTC may reduce the amount paid to reflect attendance.

Payment of Bursary

Awards are paid into the bank account of the carers at the start of each half term, the first being in early October. Students will be asked to provide evidence of the expenditure, such as a used ticket, from time to time so that the ongoing need for support can be verified.
